

Asphalt Removal to Begin from Stone Avenue to First/Euclid Avenue

Flagging operations will take place nightly, December 5 - 7th.

Crews are currently removing the existing asphalt on the north side of Grant Road from Stone Avenue to First/Euclid Avenue. The pulverized asphalt will be hauled to storage locations along the right-of-way on Grant Road from **Tuesday, December 5, 2017 through Thursday, December 7, 2017.**

To lessen the impact on the traveling public, trucks will haul the pulverized asphalt during non-peak travel hours - 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

During the haul, flaggers will direct travel at the Stone Avenue, Sixth Avenue and First/Euclid Avenue intersections at Grant Road.

The speed limit in the construction zone has been reduced to 25 mph and motorists can expect delays while traveling through the work zone. Please obey all traffic control signs and watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone. The schedule is subject to change due to equipment malfunction or inclement weather.
