

Phase 2 - Stone Avenue to Park Avenue

Construction Activities - 4th Avenue Closure

May 19, 2017

Thank you for your interest in the Grant Road Improvement Project Phase 2.

Beginning Monday, May 22 at 5:30 a.m. through Tuesday, May 23 at 4 p.m., Markham Contracting will install waterlines across Fourth Avenue at Grant Road. Residents and the traveling public can expect the following:

- Fourth Avenue will be temporarily closed just south of Grant Road
- Resident access will be maintained from Sixth Avenue and Third Avenue
- Eastbound Grant Road will be temporarily reduced to one through lane at Fourth Avenue
- Expect slight delays

Beginning Monday, May 22 through Tuesday, May 23 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day, Markham Contracting will install temporary traffic signals at the First Avenue/Grant Road intersection. During this work there will be **intermittent left turn restrictions at the First Avenue/Grant Road intersection.**

The traveling public can expect delays when driving in this work area. Please obey all traffic control signs and watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone.
