Thank you for your interest in the Grant Road Improvement Project Phase 2.

The following traffic impacts have been extended. See alert below for a revised date.

New alerts are also listed below.

Wednesday, July 26 through Monday, August 7, from 5 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day, Markham contracting will install sewer infrastructure and a storm drain along First/Euclid Avenue at Grant Road. This schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or any unforeseen circumstances. During this work, residents and the traveling public can expect the following:

- North and southbound First/Euclid Avenue will be reduced to one through lane in each direction
- Traffic will be shifted around the work areas
- All turn movements will be permitted
- Access to Walgreens from Euclid Avenue will be temporarily closed
- Business access will be maintained from Grant Road
- Speed limits will be reduced to 25 MPH. Expect delays

On Tuesday, August 1, from 5 a.m. to 4 p.m., the contractor will conduct underground electrical work on Sixth Avenue and on Hampton Street at Grant Road. During this time, residents and the traveling public can expect the following:

- Southbound Sixth Avenue through lane will be closed

- Southbound Fontana Avenue will have left and right turn lanes only
- Hampton Street will be temporarily closed
 - Residents can use Park Avenue or Euclid Avenue as alternate routes
- Traffic will be shifted around the work zones on Sixth Avenue
- Right turns from eastbound Grant Road onto southbound Sixth Avenue will not be permitted
- Left turns from westbound Grant Road onto southbound Sixth Avenue will not be permitted

On Thursday, August 3, from 5 a.m. to 4 p.m., the contractor will remove asphalt on all side street entrances along the south side of Grant Road from Sixth Avenue to Fremont Avenue. During these activities, the traveling public can **expect delays on all side streets**, however, access will be maintained at all times. **Please be advised that these side street entrances will remain as asphalt millings for the next several weeks until the contractor paves the new eastbound lanes of Grant Road. Please be cautious when driving in those areas.**

Beginning Thursday, August 3 through Thursday August 10, from 5 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day, the contractor will install waterlines along Grant Road from Ninth Avenue to Stone Avenue. During this time the traveling public can expect the following:

- Ninth Avenue will be temporarily closed
- Eastbound Grant Road will be reduced to one through lane from just west of Ninth Avenue to just west of Stone Avenue
- Sidewalks on the south side of Grant Road from just west of Ninth Avenue to just west of Stone Avenue will be temporarily closed
 - Please use the pedestrian crossing at Castro Avenue to continue heading eastbound

The traveling public can expect delays when driving in this work area. Please obey all traffic control signs and watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone.

We look forward to working with you throughout the project, and encourage any feedback.
