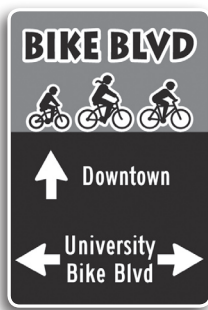

The Grant Road parallel bicycle boulevards were first suggested by citizens in 2007 during the Visioning Phase of the Grant Road Improvement Plan. While improvements to Grant Road between Oracle Road and Swan Road will include 6-foot bicycle lanes, with a 1-foot striped buffer, many residents expressed a desire for parallel bicycle boulevards as an alternative to bicycling on Grant Road. The bike boulevards were planned outside the scope of the RTA-funded Grant Road project and will be paid with other regional funds.

Planning has begun to determine the alignment and design of two bicycle boulevards parallel to Grant Road. The two corridors that are being considered as bicycle boulevards largely follow Copper and Flower Street on the north and Seneca Street on the south. Cars will still be allowed to drive and park along the bicycle boulevards, though measures to control non-local traffic could be made to increase the attractiveness to bicycle riders who prefer to ride with less traffic.

**Participants are encouraged to attend the Open House to review the recommended alignments and proposed treatments for the Copper-Flower and Seneca Bike Boulevards and provide their input.**
