

## TRAVEL LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR UTILITY ADJUSTMENTS AND PAVING OPERATIONS

*Work to start on Thursday, August 23 at 5 a.m.  
and on Friday, August 24 at 5 a.m.*

Thank you for your interest in the Grant Road Improvement Project Phase 2.

On **Thursday, August 23, 2018**, crews will lower sewer manhole covers and water valve covers on Stone Avenue and on Grant Road to prepare to mill (remove) asphalt and the final paving operations on Grant Road. The one-day utility lowering work will take place **from 5 a.m. to about 3 p.m.**

During the utility lowering work, Stone Avenue will be reduced to one travel lane in each direction from Alturas Street to Grant Road. Travel lane restrictions on Grant Road will take place at Hampton Avenue and at Santa Rita Avenue.

Similar travel lane restrictions will be in place on **Friday, August 24, 2018 from 5 a.m. to about 5 p.m.** to allow crews to mill asphalt at Stone Avenue and Alturas Street and at Grant Road and Santa Rita Avenue.

Work to widen Grant Road from Stone Avenue to Park Avenue began in March 2017. The improvements include six vehicular travel lanes, protected bike/pedestrian street crossings, drainage improvements, indirect left turns at Stone Avenue and First Avenue, bike lanes and sidewalks, bus pullouts and bus shelters, and public art.

The speed limit in the construction zone has been reduced to 25 mph and motorists can expect delays while traveling through the work zone. Please obey all traffic control signs and watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone. The schedule is subject to change due to equipment malfunction or inclement weather.

The project is part of the \$2.1 billion Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) Plan, which will be implemented through 2026. The multimodal plan, nearly halfway through implementation, includes roadway, safety, transit, environmental and economic vitality improvements. This project is managed by the City of Tucson.
